

**District Signage RFP Questions/Answers:**

1. In looking at your maps of the banner locations, there appears to be only 81 poles specified for installation, yet your request is for 100 banners. Are some of the poles going to have more than one banner mounted on them?  
No poles will have more than one banner mounted on them. We have requested additional banners for later installation and replacement.
2. It also appears that only location number 37 on Jimmy Carter requires an escort vehicle for lane blockage. Can we assume we will need to provide this vehicle and that it does not need to be a police escort?  
Yes
3. On the landscape signs, shall we assume they will all be double sided and that content will be provided by your organization?  
Landscape signs will be single-sided. Content will be provided by Gateway85 CID.
4. Will the horizontal and vertical monument signs be double sided or single sided?  
The signs should be priced as single sided and double-sided. Once locations are determined, we will know which will be installed.
5. Banner Signs – once the design is approved, will there be multiple banner designs that the signage company will need to produce or will there be a single design?  
The initial installation will be all one design.
6. Landscape Signs – what is the purpose and how will the signs be used?  
The signs will be placed in our designated landscape areas for the purpose of informing the public of our work.
7. Will the signage company be required to secure permits?  
We have permissions in place for the signs on poles. If permits are needed for monument signs, yes, the sign company will be required to secure those permits.
8. Are any of these signs located on GDOT controlled roads?  
Yes
9. Who is responsible for running the primary electrical from the source to the monument signs?  
The vendor selected will need to hire the electrician so there is a single point of contact and responsible party with whom the CID contracts.
10. Can we price everything with the exception of the installation of the illuminated street signs?  
Yes
11. Are there predetermined sizes for the large and small monument signs?
  - Primary gateway signs are to be no larger than 30' wide by 10' tall
  - Secondary gateway signs are to be no larger than 10' wide by 3' tall
  - Vertical signs are to be no longer than 3' wide by 8' tall.
  - Sizes may be modified based on site but will not be larger than listed above.
